Due to the increased emphasis on security in the supply chain, companies need to be responsible for their own compliance with these rules and restrictions. Government agencies around the world have published lists of individuals, companies and organisations they believe to be engaged in terrorist activities. Some of these lists run to hundreds of pages, making paper-based checks a very time-consuming and error-prone process.

Although the software is extremely easy to use, there are many complex processes taking place in the background to ensure the lists are checked thoroughly and accurately. The system employs fuzzy logic algorithms, phonetic agents (which enable recognition of similar-sounding words such as Stephenson and Stevenson), letter case analysers (comparing lower case and upper case words) and abbreviation profilers to ensure that nothing slips through the net.
